### PLANTING RESTRICTIONS - PER M.D. of FAIRVIEW

Information on tree plantings given to M.D. of Fairview landowners will include the following recommendations:

- Plantings along the roadside must be at least 10 m from the property line (unless otherwise approved).
- Plantings perpendicular to the road must be at least 15 m from the property line.
- If a powerline is close to your planting area, you must stay 15 m away from it if you have trees that will grow in excess of 13 m in height. You may plant shorter shrubs (e.g. Lilac, etc.) nearer the lines.
- Landowners should consider the size of their largest implement (and future implements) when planning
  the layout of the shelterbelt. Make sure that you will have enough room to move equipment freely when
  the trees are fully grown.
- Exceptions to planting restrictions may be approved by the Agricultural Fieldman on an individual basis.

## **Cautions for Town and Urban plantings:**

These trees will provide beauty and shade when they are fully grown so be sure to plant them where you want to have year-round shade. Lodgepole Pine, White & Blue Spruce, and Siberian Larch should be planted 12' to 15' apart. The Willow, Poplar and Ash should be planted 10' or so apart.

When choosing planting sites keep in mind that these tiny seedlings could grow to become massive trees, Spruce, Pine & Larch have the potential to grow to 60' in height, 20" in diameter with roots that may extend twice as far as their height.

Planting sites should be kept away from places where the branches or roots may cause issues in the future, such as future building sites, foundations, basements, sidewalks, driveways, boulevards, overhead and underground infrastructure such as power and phone lines, sewer systems, and gas or water lines.
